



## Chaplain Research Fellowship Positions

A Chaplain Research Fellowship position is a post-CPE fellowship geared toward learning to do qualitative chaplaincy research. The Fellow will also provide clinical chaplaincy at the medical center; an interest in pediatric chaplaincy is essential. The stipend is \$40,000 with 24 days PTO and is for the period 9/4/18 – 8/31/19.

In addition to the online application, applicants must provide:

- 1) One three-page paper addressing your theory or theology of chaplaincy
- 2) One two-three page essay on your research experience, or if none, what research experience you hope to gain, how you plan to use it, and why you want it.
- 3) A recent verbatim of your pastoral care
- 4) Three letters of reference from: someone familiar with your chaplaincy practice; someone familiar with your academic ability; and someone familiar with your ability to receive and use feedback
