

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Budget

Partnership Model gives more \$ flexibility

- \$2500/center for the first year for total budget of \$10,000
- \$4000 will go to content expert
 - Dr. Larry LeFlore, retired Dean TWU Graduate School
- \$350/center for Annual Subscription to Journal of HealthCare Chaplaincy
- \$250/center for library additions
- \$800/center for webcast of HealthCare Chaplaincy Conference
- \$200/center for continuing education fees





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Content Delivery

- Seminar entitled: Research Literacy for Professional Chaplaincy
- 4 partner institutions will gather on Thursday afternoons from late November-late February for ten 90 minute seminars
- 6 months remaining in residency to use information gained in this seminar
- We expect to have between 35-40 participants, including CPE supervisors
- Pretest on first day to establish knowledge baseline





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Content Delivery

Initial Seminars will include:

1. Research as a way of knowing
2. Ethical issues in research
3. Qualitative Research
4. Quantitative Research and Statistical Concepts
5. Mixed Method Research
6. How to search for journal articles using PubMed and other search engines





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Content Delivery

Second half of the unit incorporates the clinical method applied to research literacy

- Presentations of journal articles in small groups assessing the strengths and limitations of the articles as well as how they inform the residents' current practice of spiritual care
- Last seminar will include an objective exam created by the course content expert as well as a debriefing of the seminar and its applicability to their ongoing application of evidence based spiritual care





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Site Specific Learning

- Residents will be encouraged to select journal articles that reflect the patient populations where they are doing ministry
- We will provide some examples of strong research articles, but we plan to also allow the residents to learn from articles that have significant limitations as part of the learning process





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Applicability to Practice

- We will use the Rush Research Summary Outline to help residents evaluate the clinical applications of the research findings
- Addition of question to verbatim format asking how recent readings in research informed or might inform care provision





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Accountability

- Objective, multiple choice exams at the beginning and end of the seminar
- Ongoing subjective assessment of integration of learning through verbatim seminars, peer presentations of research in second half of seminar
- Assessment created by Transforming Chaplaincy Grant administrators for possible additional funding





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Enduring Commitment

- Local CPE Supervisors will take over content instruction at the conclusion of the grant funding in two years
- Given at least 4 CPE supervisors participating, we should be able to share the collaborative load moving forward
- Possibility of adding other CPE centers to this training opportunity beyond our initial partners
